<b>Running Lines:</b> Body parts kept within running lines of equip. Discuss how this could cause a hand Injuries.	<b>Dismounting:</b> Demonstrate the proper way to dismount powered equipment and ask how can I be injured? ( <i>strain / hyperextension</i> )	<b>Discussion:</b> Cross-aisle intersection safety; take meeting to this type of area.	<b>Blind Spots:</b> Ask for 3 examples and how to reduce risks.	<b>Cuts on Job:</b> Ask associates how cuts can occur in their jobs such as knives, slip sheets, nails etc.	<b>Seat Belts:</b> Why must a seatbelt be worn?	<b>Explain SLAM:</b> Continuous situation assessment: areas change all the time, wet spots, other employees, debris, etc.

<b>Evacuations:</b> Talk about meeting areas, get off equipment and walk to the evacuation areas.	<b>Crosswalks:</b> Discuss the location of crosswalks and ways reduce risk in the yard.  <b>NO PHONES!</b>	<b>Dock Door Safety:</b> Have mtg at a dock door and ask about hazards. i.e., hinges, ropes, etc.	<b>Straps:</b> Bring a strap to the meeting and ask what are a couple hazards and how to reduce risks?	<b>Propane/PPE:</b> Have a demonstration, then explain danger of a propane burn.	<b>Foot Injuries:</b> Discuss the most likely foot injury at your facility. How do you achieve ALARP?	<b>Data Plate:</b> Bring a piece of equipment to the meeting. Identify and discuss the data plate.

<b>Pinch Points:</b> Ask for areas in the facility where pinch points exist. Talk about ways to reduce risk of injury.	<b>Demonstration:</b> Show proper lifting techniques; show someone picking up a box. Ensure bend at knees, head straight, elbows in.	<b>Eyewash:</b> Talk about site-specific eyewash/shower stations, have meeting at site. Flush with baby shampoo.	<b>Use Quiz</b>	<b>Hand Injuries:</b> Ask the group how they will reduce the risk of hand injuries?	<b>Seat Belts:</b> Ask the group when must a seatbelt be worn?	<b>Housekeeping:</b> If you see something on the floor, pick it up. How can others be injured?

<b>Trailer Damage:</b> Talk about damage to the inside of trailers while loading and hazards inside.	<b>Discussion:</b> Expect the unexpected; cases falling, glass in a pick slot, nails in boards, etc.	<b>Running Lines:</b> Ask the group to show what a running line is?	<b>Inspections:</b> Have someone demonstrate a pre-trip check of powered equip. What is data plate?	<b>Hydraulic Hose Burst:</b> Explain reporting and flushing (no tear shampoo)	<b>Aisle Etiquette</b> Give a demonstration on what's expected in aisles especially when passing.	<b>Footwear:</b> Check some shoes while at meeting and talk about good foot/ankle protection.
